

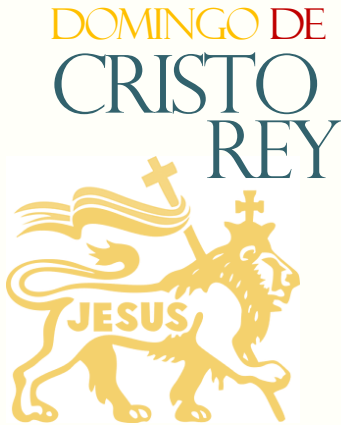

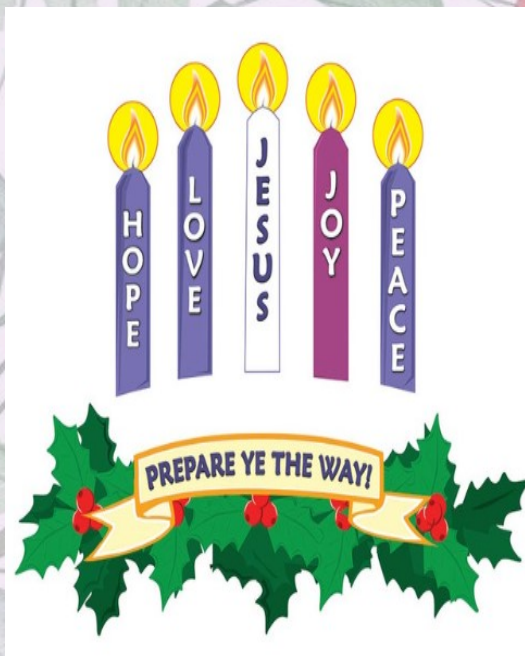

Response R/. Thanks be to God.

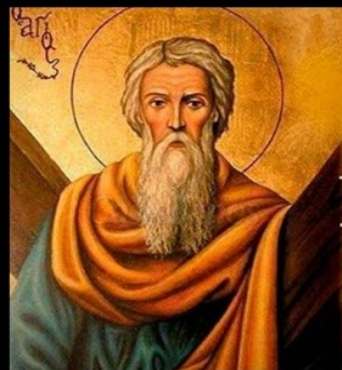

ADVENT

First Sunday of Advent

December 3, 2023

Advent is a period of preparation extending over the four Sundays before Christmas in the Catholic Church.

The word Advent comes from the Latin advenio, "to come to," and refers to the coming of Christ.

It is the beginning of the Church's liturgical year and the season encompassing the four Sundays (and weekdays) leading up to the celebration of Christmas.

The feast of Christ the King signaled the end of Ordinary Time, and Advent is the four-week liturgical season that precedes Christmas.
